

1) The only name of God is Jehova.

God also called himself the I Am and The Lord God. He said this is his name forever.

Exodus 3:14 -15

And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, the LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.

Isaiah 9:6

John 8:58

Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

John 14:9

9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father?

3) There is no Trinity.

God revealed himself in a plural form from the beginning.

Genesis 1:26-27

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Genesis 3:22

And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever:

I John 5:7

For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one

4) The resurrection of Jesus was not a bodily resurrection only spiritual.

Jesus told Thomas to touch him to prove it was a bodily resurrection.

Luke 24:39

Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.

5) Unsaved men cease to exist (annihilation of the soul) and there is no hell.

The rich man and the beggar was a real story told by Jesus as the rich man saw a real biblical figure, Abraham. Take a look at what happened to him. He was very much alive after death and was in hell.

Luke 16:22-23

And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.

6) Second coming happened in 1914 and was invisible.

Revelation 1:7
